Notice is hereby given that, after having received and given due regard to recommendations made to them by an Independent Remuneration Panel, the District Council of Huntingdonshire has approved a new scheme for the payment of allowances to District Councillors, which will operate from 1st April 2023 until the next 4-year review is undertaken.

The Council did not resolve to implement the Independent Remuneration Panel's recommendations in full but agreed to an amended version. Details of which are set out in the schedule hereunder.

- 2. Subject to the Group having at least eleven Members and being registered as a political group.
- 3. Subject to the party having a minimum of five Members and being registered as a political group.
- 4. Excluding the Chair, Vice-Chair of the Committee and any Cabinet Member appointed to the Committee

The Council has also agreed the continued payment of travel allowances in line with HM Revenue and Custom Rates, the basis of a Parental Leave Policy for Councillors and the indices to be used for indexation purposes to enable the Scheme to be increased annually in line with the percentage increase in staff salaries from the date of the annual meeting in May 2024 for a period of up to three years.
