- (b) Conducting any activities which involve accessing any property with the intent to gain access to stairs and roofs within the area of this civil injunction, that area being detailed in the map attached, without permission of the occupier or owner of the property;
- (c) To run jump or climb across rooftops within the area of this civil injunction, that area having been detailed within the attached may and plan, without the permission of the owner or occupier of the property.

This injunction will last until 6th November 2026.
